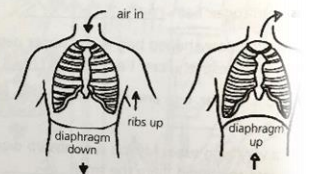
... and good health depend on a constant supply of oxygen from the air. Our lungs want clean, warm, moist air, and this is why we breathe through our nose. The windpipe, as well as the windpipe, is covered with a sticky mucus and small hairs that catch dust, soot and germs in the air we breathe.

When you breathe in, your ribs swing forwards and upwards and your diaphragm goes down.

The air you breathe passes along the windpipe and into the lungs. The lungs are spongy, fish-like organs full of tiny air passages called bronchioles. The tiny air passages lead up into air bags called alveoli.

The alveoli are covered with lots of blood vessels through which the oxygen in the air is absorbed into our blood. Millions of little red corpuscles carry the oxygen all around the body.

When you breathe out, you use the oxygen from the air, and breathe out nitrogen, carbon dioxide and other gases.
